The pub is running on a one way system, please adhere to this. The public toilets are located in the Garden Room however we would ask that you use your room facilities during your stay as it will reduce traffic in that area.

We are pleased to offer a tea and coffee tray in your room, you offer fresh milk from our fridge as well as speciality teas and a Nespresso machine along the hallway, you can of course also purchase any beverages from us and consume them in your room.

We will service your room during your stay however if you would prefer that we do not please let a member of staff know.

We have Bath House products in the bathroom, the shower gel is also a hair shampoo. We carry additional shampoo and conditioner so please don't hesitate to ask if you need it. Also large bottles can be purchased from the Garden Room.

Our lights work on a circuit so simply switch on when entering the room and to turn off use the light switch by the bed. You don't need to switch lamps on and off individually.

Safety measures

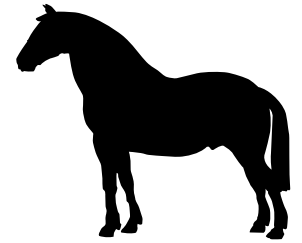
Please rest assured we are deep cleaning all the rooms on departure including extra cleaning of high risk areas such as door handles, light switches etc.
